#YouSaid - What matters to you

We have listened to your concerns and will prioritise the following areas:

Priority 1: Anti-Social Behaviour

Your Concerns: On Bonney Road, youths riding stolen motorcycles and causing anti-social behaviour (ASB) are a regular problem and pose a serious danger to local residents. **Our Actions:**

- Continued patrols at key times around the identified routes.
- 3 youths issued with 'Acceptable Behaviour Contracts'.
- Placing an Ad-van in the area to encourage residents to report incidents.

Priority 2: Dangerous Driving

Your Concerns: People using motor vehicles on the Western ward, speeding, unlawful use of E-bikes/Scooters and dangerous parking outside school gates have all be highlighted as a concern for the community. .

Our Actions:

- Officers from Nottinghamshire Police have helped local officers patrol Western Park and the wider area with off-road motorcycles in a successful proactive operation.
- Positive results with motor bikes, E-bikes & E-scooters taken off the streets.

Priority 3: Anti-Social Behaviour (Drug-related)

Your Concerns: Drug dealing and general anti-social behaviour in and around the Burns flats. Our Actions:

- Continued patrols around the Burns flats.
- An arrest of an individual who was supplying drugs in the area.
