## #YouSaidWeDid

PC Darbar located two abandoned stolen vehicles in a local car park on the North Evington beat. One of the vehicles was found to be using cloned registration plates. Please stay vigilant and report any suspicious activity you may see in your area. This includes unknown vehicles, loitering, or anything that just doesn't feel right. Officers will continue to patrol the area regularly to provide reassurance and keep your community safe.



PC 993 and PCSO 6048 attended a report of an abandoned digger in a field. After carrying out the necessary checks, it confirmed the digger had been legitimately hired for home landscaping work nearby. Everything was in order and there were no concerns. PC 993 and PCSO 6048 carried out foot patrols across Evington beat, focusing on the surrounding green spaces and cut throughs around Dudleston Close, Higgs Close, Steele Close, Humphries Close, Barnes Heath Road, and the open space behind Higgs Close. These patrols help us deter anti-social behaviour, increase visibility, as well as providing an opportunity to engage with local residents. If you see us out and about, feel free to stop and speak with us. Working together to keep our community safe.



Detectives have charged a man with a total of 13 burglary offences. Steven Lakin, 51, has been charged with 11 counts of burglary other than dwelling, one count of burglary dwelling and one count of attempted burglary other than dwelling. He has also been charged with a one count of criminal damage. Lakin appeared at Leicester Magistrates' Court on Monday 27 April and has been remanded to appear at Leicester Crown Court on Monday 15 June. The charges relate to offences that occurred between 4 February and 26 April 2026 at various locations in Leicester – including Uppingham Road, Green Lane Road, Queens Road, Hartington Road, Melton Road, Gipsy Lane, Woodgate and also Town Square in Syston.
