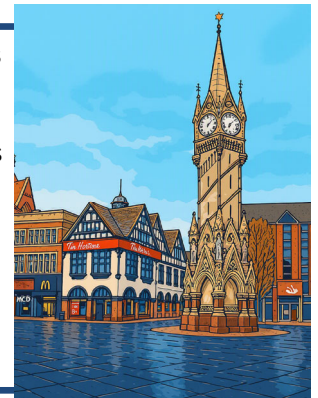

# What have we done? #WeDid



- Supporting city centre retailers through targeted action on retail crime
- Dozens of offenders charged and dealt with each month
- Criminal Behaviour Orders secured and pursued against repeat offenders
- Strong partnership working with major stores (Boots, John Lewis, Primark, Highcross, Zara)
- Ongoing crime prevention advice (CCTV, store layout, security measures)
- Regular high-visibility patrols in key retail areas
- PCSO-led engagement events in shopping centres to support businesses and the public
- Continued focus on deterrence, prevention, and strengthening retailer relationships

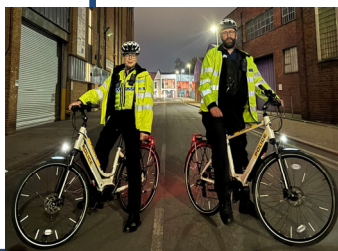
- Targeted operations delivering arrests, stop searches, safeguarding actions and ASB interventions
- Identification and management of repeat ASB offenders using incremental enforcement and court orders
- Continued use of Operation Pedalfast to tackle nuisance electric vehicles, with significant seizures
- Strong partnership working with local businesses and council to reduce ASB and improve the environment
- Action taken against issues such as street lifestyle-related ASB and false charity collectors
- Engagement events held in key locations to support and reassure the public
- Positive community feedback highlighting a noticeable reduction in crime and anti-social behaviour



- Increased high-visibility patrols across Granby Street, Belvoir Street and Town Hall Square
- Targeted enforcement including stop searches, arrests, drug seizures and positive outcomes
- Licensing checks on premises contributing to alcohol-related ASB, with warnings and court action taken
- Identification and management of repeat offenders through the incremental approach and bail conditions
- Continued use of Operation Pedalfast to tackle nuisance electric vehicles, with large numbers seized
- Ongoing engagement with local businesses and community events to provide reassurance
- Work with residential premises to secure properties and prevent ASB-related misuse
- Strong enforcement results including charges, out-of-court disposals and restrictions on offenders

PCSO's Tim and Hannah showcasing our updated E-Bike fleet. The new E-Bikes have increased our visibility around the City Centre and allowed to get places faster.



Operation Pedalfast Update; We have now seized 833 illegal electric vehicles from the City Centre. This has resulted in a significant reduction in associated crime and ASB. We want you to walk and wheel safely when visiting.
