What matters to you

• Priority 1: Burglaries.

You said: Burglaries are a concern for the neighbourhood.

We did: We have continued with increased patrols across the beat, as well as crime prevention advice delivered during scheduled beat surgeries, also through our social media page. Now that the warmer weather is coming to a close, unfortunately as the darker nights creep in we do historically see an increase in this type of crime. We will continue to conduct high visibility patrols and maintain a strong policing presence in the community.

• Priority 2:Anti-Social Behaviour (ASB)

You Said: There is an increase in concerning and upsetting ASB in the area of South Knighton Road.

We Did: Through engagement with local residents and the Leicester City Council (LCC), we were able to obtain a Section 23 Misuse of Drugs Act warrant which was executed on 10th July, resulting in an arrest. We are continuing to work with the LCC to address the issues going forward

Priority 3: The use of illegal e-scooters/bikes across the area.

You said: You see illegal and dangerous use of E-scooters/ Bikes travelling across the neighbourhood.

We did: We will continue to address this concern and tackle the use of illegal e scooter/bikes, through enforcement and seizure of the vehicles.
