#YouSaid - What matters to you

Priority 1: Drug Dealing

You said: Issues re drug dealing in the local community.

What we are going to do: Patrols are taking place throughout the day and night and stop search powers are being utilised where grounds permit. Anyone found with illegal substances on them are being dealt with accordingly. Further patrols are also taking place throughout hot spot areas to build up intelligence that can be acted on. Please continue to report any suspicious activity to us.

Priority 2: Road Safety

You said: Speeding and road safety on the beat is a concern for you.

What we are going to do: Patrols will take place in locations identified where vehicles are being used to cause harassment, alarm or distress. Section 59 powers will be utilised to take action against drivers who are causing anti social behaviour. Speed enforcement operations will be carried out across the beat to deal with those that speed excessively.

Priority 3: Anti-social Behaviour

You Said: Concerns raised relating to youth related Anti Social Behaviour.

What we are going to do: Support residents on an individual basis where complaints are made, challenge those involved and work with partner agencies to implement outcomes. Complete targeted patrols where identified to disrupt and challenge behaviour. These issues can occur anywhere, so we rely on your communication to tackle these issues.

#WeDid - What we are doing

PCSO Fenner RUSHBY has now joined the NR 32 beat and will actively patrolling hotspot areas as well as engaging with those identified to be causing Anti Social Behaviour.

PCSO Malcolm Durrant will also be spending time on the NR 32 Beat also actively patrolling the hot spot locations.

Drug Dealing

The local Neighbourhood priority team have recently utilised stop search powers and searched a male linked to
drug activity in the area. This male was found to be in possession of a quantity of Class A substances and was arrested on suspicion of possession with intent to supply Class A. An investigation is now underway,

Anti-Social Behaviour

- A resident was recently charged for harassment and criminal damage offences against his neighbour.
- The police and crime commissioner visited an Anti Social Behaviour hot spot location on the beat.

Crime & Patrols

- High-visibility **foot patrols** were conducted in hotspot areas.
- We have been supporting our response teams with **live incidents** throughout June too and completing high visible patrols often on foot in some of our hotspot areas.

- We have been dealing with local issues such as Antisocial Behaviour and safeguarding vulnerable residents as and when we identify concerns.
- Ongoing patrols in areas of concerns to identify those involved and reduce incidents. Some of these areas include the Melton Mowbray Town Centre and areas on the beat linked to drug activity.
- Work ongoing with local schools where incidents of bullying and assaults have been brought to the attention of Police.
- We have also been helping in regarding to other issues that come to Police such as neighbour disputes, events that impact and cause community concerns, gaining intelligence regarding criminal activity and addressing community safety concerns.
