What matters to you

We have listened to you and the concerns you raised and prioritized the following:

Priority 1: Antisocial Behaviour

The community have raised the issue of Anti-Social Behaviour on the Melton Town Beat as a top priority.

What we have done: Hot spot patrols are in place for this across the areas of concern.

We are acutely aware it is School Holidays, and this historically leads to an increase in ASB. We are working closely with Melton Council and other partner agencies. For example the recent window smashes on Nottingham Street and suspects identified.

Priority 2: Drug Dealing

The community have raised the issue of drug dealing on the Melton Town Beat. Our specialized teams are having good results based on local intelligence and targeted observations and will be doing our Police version of 'Surprise Surprise' again very shortly.

What we have done: Closure and partial closure orders were executed at numerous addresses and there are future plans in place regarding other areas of concern. Patrols have been increased in the areas of the closures to ensure compliance. Intel is coming in daily regarding new addresses and also persons which officers are increasing the proactive patrols around certain areas.

Priority 3: Theft and Burglary

What we have done: Along with other officers locked up offenders, some twice in a week, three local and prolific shoplifters and put them before the courts. Patrolled daily as a pro active measure to deter further thefts and develop intelligence going forward.

The town beat team have participated in the FATAL 4 Operation, which was organised by traffic officers and volunteers from Leicestershire Police. This initiative targeted the four main causes of fatal road incidents:

- Drink/drug driving
- Speeding
- Not wearing seatbelts
- Using mobile phones while driving
