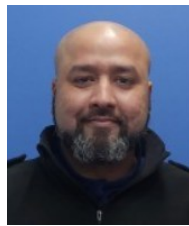

Your priorities are chosen quarterly and are based upon information gathered through NHL (Neighbourhood Link), social media, local engagement, and emerging crime trends. You have stated that the following key themes are

You Said	We did
Reports of drug dealing and using at several addresses on the beat, attracting undesirables to the location and often resulting in ASB (Anti-Social Behaviour) and disorder at the addresses.	The Beat Team have been working closely with HBBC and local HA's in a joint agency approach in order to tackle local hotspots and persistent offenders. Recent successes have included a Court Order for tenancy breaches, Community protection notices and Police action for cannabis use. Eviction notices have also been issued.
Speeding of vehicles along several roads on the beat, breaches of weight restrictions and bridge strikes all lead to a feeling amongst the community that road safety is an issue.	A local Speeding Op was organised along Coventry Road and most recently a Fatal 4 along the A5 with colleagues from RPU. This resulted in 18 drivers being caught for traffic related offences.
Theft of and theft from motor vehicles continues to be a problem over the Greater Hinckley beat area.	Regular patrols are being undertaken with intel being submitted and acted upon. Advice has been given regarding security. We are working closely with Warwickshire, West Mids and Staffordshire forces in order to catch perpetrators and disrupt activity.

News

A Community Event was recently organised by Riverside Housing and attended by PCSO Steve from Hinckley Police Neighbourhood Policing Team. Duties for the day included, speaking with neighbours regarding ASB and fly tipping around the location and the hard working team from Riverside were there to assist neighbours with removing any unwanted items and help clear up the area, a great job. our Community. Antisocial behaviour and fly tipping might seem like small problems, but they have a big impact on our neighbourhood. When rubbish is dumped or people behave in a way that causes distress or nuisance, it affects everyone. It makes our streets look and feel less safe; Piles of rubbish, vandalism and nuisance behaviour can make people feel uncomfortable walking around their own area and it harms our sense of pride. When places look neglected, it sends the message that nobody cares — even though most residents do. If you see ASB or fly tipping, please report it.

Due to concerns from residents regarding speeding vehicles along Coventry Road, PCSO Steve, PCSO Corrie and one of our Police volunteers organised a speeding Op, SL700 in hand. On this occasion it was to assess driver behaviour around certain times. Apart from one individual, drivers kept within the speed limit. Another driver decided that it was an ideal opportunity to approach us and become verbally abusive. Unfortunately for him he has been issued with a S59. Later checks revealed that he was also driving without insurance and will be reported to the DVLA. Vehicle will also be seized.

PC Wood has been dealing with spree burglaries around Hinckley. A good result though with the alleged Suspect arrested and bailed pending further enquiries.

We also have a new Student PCSO 6668 Mohammed Hossain currently in Company and gaining important experience on the beat, looking to go independent in due course. Welcome to the team !
