## What matters to you

### 1. Burglary Prevention

We will work closely with residents and partner agencies to reduce opportunities for dwelling burglaries. Activity will include targeted patrols, routine crime prevention advice, and increased seasonal awareness during the spring and summer months.

### 2. Misuse of E-Scooters & E-Bikes in Public Spaces

We are committed to tackling the anti social and dangerous use of e-scooters and illegal e-bikes, particularly when ridden on pavements and through parks. This priority involves regular enforcement, educating the public on legislation, and seizing illegal vehicles where necessary.

### 3. Drug Activity (Nitrous Oxide) – Lynwood Court & Laureston Drive

We will focus on addressing drug related activity in and around Lynwood Court and Laureston Drive. This includes increasing visible patrols, reducing drug related behaviour, and working with residents to identify individuals involved.



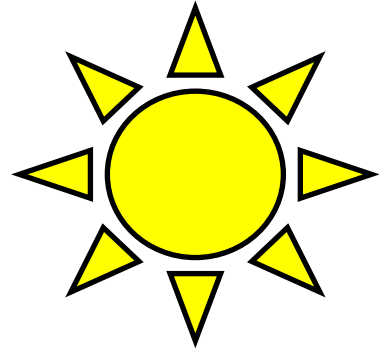
## Other Local News
