

Beat Priorities—#yousaidwedid

As a result of both meeting local residents and engagement via Neighbourhood Link the beat priorities are:

- Rural theft—residents are concerned about the theft of farm machinery
- Road safety– the B047 is a road of concern for residents
- Drugs—concerns about drug taking on the beat

#wedid

- Rural theft— working with neighbouring forces and the rural policing team we have made some key arrests that have led to a reduction of theft and burglaries on the beat.
- Road safety
 – high visibility patrols and ops have taken place and are planned for the hotspot areas: B6047, A606 and A6006
- Drugs—increased patrols in areas where drug taking is prevalent.
