We have listened to you and the concerns you raised and prioritised the following:

**Priority 1: Anti-social behaviour**

**You Said:** Anti-social behaviour within your area is causing a concern. This includes acts of drug taking, excessive noise from vehicles and groups of youths.

**What we are going to do:** The local neighbourhood team are currently dealing with a group who are causing ASB in our community. We are in the process of identifying offenses as well as individuals whom we will be going through the incremental approach with them and continue monitoring their behaviour.


**Priority 2: Road traffic Issues**

**You Said:** Issues in relation to parking, speeding and anti-social driving are causing concerns in your area.

**What we are going to do:** Now that more officers are trained using the Speed Gun; officers will be conducting regular speed checks in the South Wigston area. With regards to the Nuisance Motorbikes if you have any further information relating to their movements or an address where they store the bikes then please get in contact with us.

On a separate note there's still lots of surface water and some areas in the county are flooded. Stay safe and take care on roads.
