We have listened to you and the concerns you have raised and set our priorities for April / May / June to reflect this.

### Priority 1: To reduce and prevent cycle theft in the City Centre

## What have we done #WeDid



- We have conducted 8 dedicated bike register events to increase the security of your trusted two wheeled transport.
- We have charged 3 suspects for multiple theft of cycle offences.
- We have been working with Leicester City Council on a digital campaign regarding anti-theft measures and correct locking for cycles.
- Project Relock has also continued to support victims of cycle theft. Any person who has been victim to a theft of their bike is entitled to receive a free gold standard D-lock and have their new bike signed up to the Bike Register.

-We have dealt with over 30 individuals for anti-social behaviour and they are at different stages of the incremental approach which has included verbal advice, written warnings and criminal behaviour orders.

-We have conducted multiple partner agency visits with stores including Chopstix, Highcross, Tim Hortons, Greggs, McDonalds, Fresh Bake to support local businesses with ASB.

-During school holidays we have increased patrols in transport hubs, shopping areas and fast food retailers.



-Operation Pedalfast is our response to community concerns relating to the use of illegal e-scooters and over-powered/modified e-bikes being driven through the City Centre.

-We are currently at a seize without warning stance.

-We have now seized a combined total 239 illegal e-scooters and overpowered/modified e-bikes.

-We have worked with other partners including Leicester City Council and Immigration to ensure the message is clear—illegal vehicles will be seized!

We conducted a week long knife crime intensification operation, during this we completed knife sweeps, knife arch deployments and test purchase operations to reduce and prevent knife crime.
