What matters to you

The Neighbourhood beat priorities reflect what you have raised and made us aware:

You Said: Priority 1: Vehicle Crime-Theft of Motor Vehicles/Theft from Motor Vehicles - Through reports and community consultations with residents and Leicester City Council. We have identified locations by mapping crimes on the Neighbourhood beat area.

We Did: providing crime preventative and crime reduction information through social media for keeping vehicles secure, particularly those that leave them on display or those that leave their work kit in their work vehicles, your local Neighbourhood beat team will continue to police patrols in the area,

You Said: Priority 2: Victoria Park - Anti -Social- Behaviour, Victoria Park Car park also known as Granville Road car park, through reports and community consultations, local park users and Leicester City Council, we have identified this location for where vehicles are driven at speed in the car park,

We Did: officers have issued Section 59 warnings to drivers using vehicles in an anti-social manner, causing Harassment, Alarm and Distress We will continue to conduct visible patrols and work with Leicester City council parks team, to ensure it is a safe environment at this location, especially in the late evenings.

You Said: Priority 3: Anti-Social –Behaviour on Clarendon Park area, where person/s causing issues in the neighbourhood by knocking on doors, causing issues to residents of clarendon park area.

We Did: we have and will continue patrolling the streets in the neighbourhood area and checking any CCTV footage to identify person/s responsible.

We will continue with our engagements/community consultations, where officers conduct regular beat surgeries and community engagements face-to-face meeting and urging our members of the local community to come and raise their concerns, also your Neighbourhood beat officers have been busy with **SAFER STREETS WINTER** initiative where officers conducted proactive patrols to tackle ASB and retail crime.

Other Local News

- **Victoria Park**- Officer's have conducted visible foot patrols on Victoria park, also monitoring the car park for speeding vehicles, given Section 59 warning Notices/ vehicles taken off the road for not being insured or taxed.
- **Queens Road/Welford Rd**- in relation to E-Scooters/E-Bikes, officers have conducted number of stops and seized illegal/ modified bikes.
