What matters to you

Our priorities for this month are: Burglaries; Theft from motor vehicles; seasonal crime due to dark evenings. These have been identified through crime stats, neighbourhood surveys and our engagements

What we will do

To tackle the issues raised we will conduct a number of focused actions which will include;

-Conduct reassurance visits to victims of burglary to prevent them becoming a repeat victim

-Engagements within our carparks offering crime prevention advice to our commuters and visitors.

-Patrols of our hot spot areas where we have received reports of ASB and criminality in relation to dark evenings.

--Engagements within our residential areas to offer reassurance and collect intelligence about crimes and ASB happening in the area.

Whilst completing hotspot patrols around the cultural quarter officers have seized a number of vehicles for various offences; including no tax, no insurance and even stolen.
