What matters to you

We have identified the following priorities which are in place as of 1st July 2026:

- **Priority 1: Anti-Social Behaviour (ASB)**

You Said: ASB is prevalent in the local area and continues to cause concerns, particularly within the estate.

We Did: The local beat team continues to address reports of ASB, particularly involving groups of young people. Officers have been working with partner agencies to identify repeat offenders and take appropriate action where necessary. Engagement with residents and young people remains a priority to prevent further incidents. With the return to school for children after the summer break, we are likely to see a decrease in ASB reporting over the coming months.

- **Priority 2: Drug Dealing**

You Said: Drug dealing continues to be a key issue around the estate.

We Did: Targeted patrols and intelligence-led operations continue to be undertaken to disrupt drug-related activity on the estate. Local officers are working closely with Leicester City Council to take positive action against addresses linked to the supply and use of illegal drugs. Information provided by the community remains vital in helping us to target offenders and keep the area safe.

- **Priority 3: Off-Road Vehicles**

You Said: In previous years as we head towards the summer, off-road bikes and quad bikes start to become an issue – being ridden illegally and dangerously in open and green spaces.

We Did: We continue to receive reports of off-road bikes being ridden on open spaces and residential areas across Eyres Monsell. These vehicles cause significant concern within the community due to the risk they can pose to the law abiding public. Over the last month, officers have conducted targeted patrols in hotspot locations and have acted on information provided by residents. A number of illegal off-road bikes have been seized last month. The local team will continue dedicated patrols and where offenders can be identified we will take robust enforcement action.

Other Local News

- ♦ Local PCSOs have recently visited Rolleston Primary School to speak with the Foundation classes, answering questions from the children. They also showed the children their uniform and equipment as well as giving them a tour of a police car.
