## You said - We did

- Speeding (34 votes on Neighbourhood Link (NHL)). Between 01/10/2025 and 31/10/2025 the mobile speed camera visited the A47 four times, the B6047 two times, and the Smeeton Westerby six times. In total forth eight offences were detected.
- Anti social behaviour (21 votes on NHL) identifying individuals causing the anti social behaviour. Passing their names to the council to start the incremental approach. Targeting areas of known ASB activity.
- Nuisance motorbikes (19 votes on NHL) We have been conducting uniformed and marked vehicle patrols in the areas you have told us this is a problem. We have directed officers to these areas in any down time they have to deter these offenders from causing problems in these areas.

In the process a stolen quad bike was recovered and was returned to its rightful owner. Also during the incident, several tools were also recovered, believed to be stolen. Some safety tips to protect your vehicles & contents:

Use high-quality wheel locks and hitch locks for caravans and trailers. Install GPS trackers on motorhomes and high-value vehicles. Park in well lit, secure areas and consider CCTV coverage. Remove valuables and documents from vehicles when unattended. Report suspicious activity immediately via 101 or online.
