#YouSaid - What matters to you

Coalville Beat Priorities: April – June 2026

ASB in local authority and privately run car parks

You said: We are aware of continued issues with inconsiderate drivers causing general ASB within local car parks.

We will: We are working with local security and CCTV operatives to run specific operations to address this issue. We will spend time monitoring the car parks and any misuse will be dealt with as appropriate.

Drug dealing and associated ASB within the town centre beat.

You Said: You have raised concerns regarding drug use and the anti-social behaviour associated with this type of criminality.

We Will: We have received several reports relating to issues surrounding drug use in our town centre. We are looking at enforcement options and working with partners to tackle the issue.

School Parking and traffic issues.

You Said: You have raised concerns relating to road safety, specifically surrounding our local primary schools. This includes driving at excess speed for the location, inappropriate road use and dangerous parking.

We Will: We will complete targeted operations in the areas concerned and look to offer education and enforcement where required. We will work with partners in enforcement and ensure action is taken where appropriate.

#WeDid - What we are doing

Childs cycle recovered and returned within 24 hours.

Officers working together across several departments have successfully located and returned a child's pushbike to its rightful owner—just 24 hours after it was reported stolen. Thanks to quick teamwork, good local enquiries, and information from the community, the bike was recovered in good condition and reunited to the family of a very happy young owner. Great work by everyone involved, and a big thank you to local residents for continuing to support us in keeping North West Leicestershire safe.



#WeDid - What we are doing

Speeding checks conducted Forest Road.

Following concerns raised by local residents, officers from the Coalville Town Beat Team have been out on patrol conducting speed checks on Forest Road, Coalville.

We're happy to report that on this occasion no drivers were found exceeding the speed limit. Thank you to everyone who continues to drive safely and responsibly in our community.



Great Teamwork in Coalville Leads to Multiple Arrests!

Our eagle-eyed Coalville Town PCSOs were out on patrol when they spotted a male wanted for theft and recall to prison. They kept him in sight and relayed updates to the Safer Streets Team and NPT.

The male disappeared into an address... and moments later another male tried to flee on a bike. He didn't get far — stopped and found to be wanted for robbery.

Officers gained entry to the address where the original suspect was located and arrested for shop theft and recall to prison.

Inside was also another male wanted for robbery! 3 wanted males located, 2 for robbery, 1 for theft & recall.



Parking Enforcement – Coalville Beat

As part of our beat priorities over the next three months, we have been carrying out joint patrols with North West Leicestershire District Council's enforcement team to address unsafe and inconsiderate parking.

During today's patrols, parking tickets were issued. While we understand how frustrating this can be, particularly for parents collecting children, the restrictions are in place to keep everyone safe. Parking on double yellow lines, across private driveways, or on junctions creates risks for pedestrians, other road users, and emergency access. These patrols will continue over the coming months in the Coalville beat.
