#YouSaid - What matters to you

Priority 1: Drug Dealing

You said: Issues re drug dealing in the local community.

What we are going to do: Patrols are taking place throughout the day and night and stop search powers are being utilised where grounds permit. Anyone found with illegal substances on them are being dealt with accordingly. Further patrols are also taking place throughout hot spot areas to build up intelligence that can be acted on. Please continue to report any suspicious activity to us.

Priority 2: Road Safety

You said: Speeding and road safety on the beat is a concern for you.

What we are going to do: Patrols will take place in locations identified where vehicles are being used to cause harassment, alarm or distress. Section 59 powers will be utilised to take action against drivers who are causing anti social behaviour. Speed enforcement operations will be carried out across the beat to deal with those that speed excessively.

Priority 3: Anti-social Behaviour

You Said: Concerns raised relating to youth related Anti Social Behaviour.

What we are going to do: Support residents on an individual basis where complaints are made, challenge those involved and work with partner agencies to implement outcomes. Complete targeted patrols where identified to disrupt and challenge behaviour. These issues can occur anywhere, so we rely on your communication to tackle these issues.

It has been a busy and productive month for the **NR32 Town North Beat Team**, with significant proactive work carried out to tackle drug-related crime, anti-social behaviour, and wider community concerns.

NR32 Beat Newsletter – Monthly Update Overview

The NR32 Beat Team have been busy this month, focusing on tackling drugs, anti-social behaviour, and safeguarding vulnerable members of the community. Below is a summary of our key activity and outcomes.

Drugs Enforcement

- PC O'Rourke assisted the **Melton Town South** Beat during major drugs enforcement at an address on Blackberry Crescent involving multiple teams from across Leicestershire Police which resulted in the arrest of 6 people.
- A male was also arrested on the Beat on suspicion of **Possession with Intent to Supply Class B** drugs after the vehicle he was driving was stopped by officers.

Anti-Social Behaviour (ASB)

- We have seen increased reports of Anti-social Behaviour around **Melton Country Park**, particularly in regards to lighting of fires and swimming in the lakes. **We strong urge against getting in the water** due to cold water shock and the possibility of dangerous items lurking under the surface. We will also be conducting **high-visibility foot patrols** to challenge any antisocial behaviour observed and gathering intelligence around fire lighting– identifying and dealing with suspects.

Community & Safeguarding

- Officers visited **vulnerable members of the community** to ensure safeguarding needs were met and to provide continued support.

These visits help maintain strong relationships with individuals who may require additional assistance or protection.

With the weather (slightly) improving as we head into Spring, we have unfortunately seen an increase in Road Traffic Collisions this month.

Nottingham Road continues to be an area of concern with another collision taking place, thankfully with no injuries reported. The Beat Team will be out and about providing a visible presence and dealing with traffic offences where they arise.

We once again urge drivers to take care on the roads, and to be aware of the increase of vulnerable road users such as cyclists and motorcyclists now the weather is turning more pleasant.
