What we are doing

Recently, we've seen an increase in reports of street drinking on and around St James Road. PCSO Trantom has been actively patrolling the area and has identified nine individuals involved. As a result, five people have received written warnings, while four have been given verbal advice. We are taking an incremental approach to address this issue, aiming to effectively reduce street drinking in the area. This will be a long term project utilizing both criminal and civil powers to deal with street drinking related anti-social behaviour.

What we are doing

At the recent Stoneygate ward meeting, Sgt. Chris Brown updated the community on the team's recent activities. A key issue raised was the persistent problem of speeding on and around Evington Lane. Sgt. Brown explained that effective speed enforcement requires carefully chosen locations that meet specific safety criteria. These criteria include a clear line of sight on a straight road for accurate speed measurement, sufficient cover for officer safety, and enough space to safely pull over vehicles.

To address this issue, PC Woolley and PCSO Trantom have been tasked with identifying suitable spots and conducting speed enforcement checks. Over the coming weeks, you will see them out at various locations performing these checks. These efforts are crucial for ensuring the safety of the public and other motorists. Drivers who fail to adhere to speed limits may face penalties, including fines and points on their licenses.





This month, PC Woolley received his long service medal, marking 20 years of dedicated service to the communities of Leicester, Leicestershire, and Rutland. Throughout his career, PC Woolley has responded to various police emergencies across the county.

In 2021, he took on a new challenge by joining the Stoneygate ward, an area of policing that was new to him. Drawing on his extensive experience, PC Woolley has successfully engaged with the community and tackled the crimes that matter most to residents. One notable contribution he has made to the Stoneygate team is his passion for traffic enforcement. He is often seen on Evington Road, addressing issues with vehicles blocking the highway or being abandoned while owners pick up food.
