You said - We did

- Speeding (10 votes on Neighbourhood Link (NHL)). Between 01/12/2025 and 31/12/2025 local neighbourhood officers visited various sights across the area to undertake speeding enforcement.
- Anti social behaviour (10 votes on NHL) - identifying individuals causing the anti social behaviour. Passing their names to the council to start the incremental approach. Targeting areas of known ASB activity.
- Drug dealing (11 votes on NHL) - We have been conducting plain clothes patrols in areas we are told drug dealing is an issue. We collect intelligence from residents and CrimeStoppers and apply for magistrates warrants and conduct drugs raids on those we suspect of dealing in drugs. We encourage anyone to report drug dealing to us anonymously through CrimeStoppers.



During the month of December, Inspector Perry's held a public engagement event as she often does, and had a couple of surprise visitors. PC Paul Williams and PC Emily Hatfield were passing by, spotted what was going on, and couldn't resist popping in to say hello!

Although Christmas is over, here are some tips on how to keep your belongings safe when shopping in town:

- ☑ Keep your bags closed and valuables secure
- ☑ When parking ensure your car is locked and valuables are away from sight
- ☑ Be aware of your surroundings – thieves rely on distraction
- ☑ Report suspicious activity – either let staff know in the store or let the police know immediately
- ☑ If your cards are stolen make sure you report it to the bank as soon as possible to prevent the card being used further
