What have we done

- We have organised a number of speeding operations utilising speed guns. We have also requested the mobile speed enforcement van to attend various locations on the area to assist us. This month we held a patch walk at Wellington Place on the edge of Harborough in response to fears by residents of anti social behaviour. A patch walk entails a walk round the area, noting specific areas of concern and looking at possible preventative measures. Those who attended were local police, Harborough District Council Community Safety, Environmental Crime officers and local Councillors. We would always encourage people to report ASB.
