What matters to you

From information collated from local surveys, beat knowledge, intelligence and reports to Leicestershire Police, the following areas have been highlighted as priorities within the community:

- **Priority 1: Park Hill Drive - Anti-Social Behaviour and Drug Use**

You said: An increase in Anti Social Behaviour and Drug use in the area of Park Hill Drive

We did: A lot of work has been put in around Park Hill Drive, the last month has meant establishing what our issues are with community forums and taking action on any issues that have arisen. Positive outcomes, such as arrests, have come of this and thanks to PCSO Preston's hard work, we have a good grip on a lot of the issues raised in this area.

- **Priority 2: Montrose Road - Drug Dealing and Anti-Social Behaviour**

You said: An increase in Anti-Social Behaviour and drug activity in the area.

We did: We have been proactively working in this area to better manage any drug-related issues and anti-social behaviour. By doing this, we have identified addresses that were being cuckooed and have made arrests in relation to this. Properties that were being damaged have been reported to us and we have dealt with this also.

- **Priority 3: Aylestone Meadows - Anti-Social Behaviour through use of motorbikes**

You said: An increase of Anti-Social Behaviour on Aylestone Meadows involving motorbikes

We did: Patrols have been put in place as frequently as possible due to the higher levels of anti-social behaviour through the summer. Any issues identified either through reporting or coming across it ourselves have been dealt with promptly. We are still working on making this a safe place for all by joining up with our local council team.
