We have listened to you and the concerns you raised and will prioritise the following in July 2023.

Priority 1: Drug Use/Supply

Priority 2: ASB (In open spaces)

You Said: Anti-Social Behaviour in open spaces on the Riverside beat was of concern to you.

What we are going to do: *Targeted patrols *Use of PSPO powers *Educational Events * Partnership Working

What we are doing

- We have been working with the Leicester Riders Foundation to provide sports opportunities for young people on the Riverside beat as a diversionary activity to prevent antisocial behaviour.
- We continue to work with staff and patients at the Leicester Royal Infirmary to address violence offences against staff, theft of cycles and disorderly behaviour.
- We continue to support DMU students to ensure a safe environment to aid their studies and social activities.
- Community Consultations to hear your views which assists us in priority setting in the future.
