# What matters to you

We have listened to you and the concerns you raised and will priorities the following from March 2025.

**Priority 1: ASB. You said**: You have concerns around antisocial behavior across the village. We will continue to try and disrupt this type of behavior and use the ASB incremental approach to deter offenders.

**Priority 2: Speeding. You said:** You are concerned about vehicles speeding in the villages. We will continue to monitor and enforce speed across several sites in the village.

**Priority 3: Burglaries**. We aim to work with the relevant authorities to reduce the burglaries across the village and to try and reduce the number of reported thefts from the recycling centre. Visiting victims and offering crime prevention advice.

## May 2025

#### Priority 1: The beat team aim to tackle different elements of ASB in Mountsorrel

During the month of May we have patrolled the ASB hotspots within the village. We have identified an emerging issue of individuals ridding around the village on bikes but in particular Halsted Park. Through working with the local community we have identified one of the males. He has had a visit from Officers to instruct him of what will happen in the future if he continues and he is seen by a Police Officer ridding a bike. We are still working to identify others involved. If you see anyone ridding around the village can you please report it to us via 101. Officers will attend if they are available to do so but the most important thing for the Beat Team is for residents to report any incidents to us so it helps build a picture of the issue and spot any patterns. We can then target an area at a specific time if we believe the ridders will be in a location.

## Priority 2: The beat team aim to target reports of speeding in Mountsorrel.

#### **Speed Ops**

Speed checks were completed on Leicester Road and West Cross Lane on Tuesday 6<sup>th</sup> May 2025. We were not visible to motorists to see if the locations are still an issue. Based on the data gained we will be continuing visible checks at both locations. There are more speed operations planned in the coming months.

### **Priority 3: Burglaries**

Burglary patrols are continuing during the day and night in the village. I am pleased to say that burglaries have reduced. The police computer systems have been checked and we have not had any reported burglaries in the past forty days.
