Concerns relating to Road Safety whether it be parking, speeding or loud vehicles causing a nuisance or motorbikes being ridden in an anti-sociable manner.	A number of vehicles have been removed this month for either being SORN and on the public highway or no tax.
Drug dealing/taking. Drug dealing on the beat is still a priority. We are always looking for opportunities to gather sufficient intelligence to enforce by way of drugs warrants. Any opportunity to disrupt drug dealing will be grasped by the team.	ASB advice letter and verbal advice has been given to two different houses on the beat in regards to smoking cannabis and the victims kept updated with outcome.
Anti-Social Behaviour. Where ASB has occurred reports have been made and identifiable perpetrators have been dealt with.	Patrols in hot spot areas completed. Issues reported on parks were addressed and dealt with.

### **News**

Last Thursday a multi-agency patch walk took place in Barwell. Our thanks to Hinckley & Bosworth Borough Council, Leicestershire Fire and Rescue Service , Head of Community Safety Cllr Michael Mullaney and officers from the councils housing and community safety teams for attending. Great opportunity to speak to residents, dropping off information leaflets and speaking to them about any concerns they may have, and where possible helping or directing them to other agencies or support services.

PC Nik attended the Church Lane/Thurlaston Lane area of Earl Shilton in relation to complaints received of motorists deliberately ignoring the temporary road closures in place for essential utilities works being carried out . Not only is this dangerous as the road is unsafe whilst work is being carried out, it is also unsafe for the workers on the road who are regularly being verbally abused by motorists when challenged, is also unsafe for pedestrians as motorists are using the foot path to squeeze through. While PC Nik was there several drivers were caught ignoring the sign and tried to squeeze past him and the marked police car. The best excuse being "THE SAT NAV SAID IT WAS

OK". All were turned around with the appropriate words of advice given. In future motorists will be dealt with in the form of Traffic Offence Reports meaning potential points on licenses and fines. If there is evidence of road workers being verbally abused this will also be progressed as a public order offence.
