

Neighbourhood Link is a community messaging service from Leicestershire Police that provides news and information about policing activity or initiatives, crime prevention advice as well as major incidents affecting your area.

Through this service you can receive messages from your local Neighbourhood Policing Team, local police or, in the event of a major incident or event affecting the whole of Leicestershire, from a partnership of agencies known as the Local Resilience Forum.

In order to receive messages, you will need to register your details. Registration is free and simple to follow.

- If you are already registered you can amend your details
- Request a reminder if you have forgotten your username or password
- You can unsubscribe from the service at any time

Neighbourhood Link is not able to receive messages and you should not use it to contact the police. In an emergency always dial 999. If you wish to contact Leicestershire Police in other circumstances, for example to speak to local police or seek advice on police matters, you can call us by dialling 101 on your telephone.

New Police Commander for North West Leicestershire

Meet North West Leicestershire's new Neighbourhood Policing Area Commander – Inspector Wayne Nimblette.

With 21 years of service, Inspector Nimblette has worked in a variety of policing roles including as a police Constable and Sergeant working in Response; in Neighbourhood Policing; and as an Operational Inspector. The past nine months has seen him carry out the role as staff officer to the Chief Constable.

Speaking about his new role, Inspector Nimblette said: "I'm looking forward to the new challenge, to engaging with people in the community, and to helping to keep the area a safe place to live, work and enjoy".

"I'm excited to get working with the brilliant neighbourhood teams and to help continue the great work which has been and is being done".

Inspector Nimblette takes over from the previous Commander for the area, Inspector Rich Muldoon. After just over a year as Neighbourhood Policing Area Commander, Inspector Muldoon will be taking on a new role as Chief Inspector in the Force's Specialist Support Directorate.

He said: "The past year has flown by and I have been incredibly privileged to work alongside a team of officers, police staff and partners who have worked tirelessly to keep North West Leicestershire safe, often in very difficult circumstances".

"My successor, Inspector Wayne Nimblette, joins the team with a wealth of experience across a broad range of policing areas. I know that I am leaving North West Leicestershire in very safe hands."
