What matters to you

We have identified the following priorities which are in place as of 1st April 2026:

- **Priority 1: Anti-Social Behaviour (ASB)**

You Said: ASB is prevalent in the local area and continues to cause concerns, particularly within the estate.

We Did: Local officers have continued to proactively patrol the ASB hotspots as well as the green open spaces on the beat. We have also continued our joint approach effort with Leicester City Council's ASB team to visit and support victims of ASB as well as dealing with perpetrators of ASB in an appropriate manner.

- **Priority 2: Drug Dealing**

You Said: Drug dealing continues to be a key issue around the estate.

We Did: Officers have continued to carry out proactive stop checks across the estate, one of which resulted in the seizure of drugs from an address. The investigation remains ongoing.

- **Priority 3: Off-Road Vehicles**

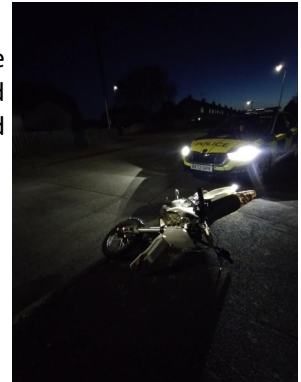
You Said: In previous years as we head towards the summer, off-road bikes and quad bikes start to become an issue – being ridden illegally and dangerously in open and green spaces.

We Did: As the summer months approach we have set up Operation Yatter to tackle the issues with off road bikes on the open spaces around the beat. Officers will be using various tactics to deter, or catch perpetrators in the area. We will be utilising various methods that have proved successful in previous summers.

Other Local News

The Eyres Monsell beat team continues to tackle our priorities that are decided by you, the residents of Eyres Monsell. One of our priorities is off road bikes. PC Michael has launched OP YATTER this month to tackle the issue. This had led to several off road bikes being seized by PC Michael and PC Nat

PCSO Tay and PCSO Sam have been working closely with the Leicester City Council community safety team to tackle anti-social behaviour. We work with our partner agencies to deal with perpetrators of anti-social behaviour. They are dealt with via the incremental approach, that can start at advice being given all the way to court action if behaviour continues to cause issues. We also work together to help victim of anti-social behaviour.
