# What matters to you?

We have listened to you and the concerns you raised and will prioritise the following in May 2024.

Priority 1: Anti-Social Behaviour

You said: We have received reports of ASB related behaviour with motorbikes on the beat.

Priority 2: Road Safety

You said: Concerns relating Road Safety whether it be parking, speeding or loud car causing nuisance.

Priority 3: Drug Dealing and Drug Taking

You said: Reports of smell of cannabis and cars coming and going from locations exchanging packages.

## What we are doing

We have listened to you and the concerns you raised and will prioritise the following in May 2024.

Priority 1: Anti-Social Behaviour - We did: Throughout April we received eight reports relating to ASB. Six of these reports were attended and the non attended incidents a follow up call was made to obtain further details. Further motorbikes have been seized and Section 59 notices issued to perpetrators.

Priority 2: Road Safety - We did: We have been issuing vehicles with section 59 notices as well as Traffic Offence Reports (TOR) for Driving without due care and attention (3-9 points on licence).

Priority 3: Drug Dealing and Drug Taking - We did: We have been regularly patrolling hot spot areas for drug taking and keeping an eye out for vehicles and people of interest. A warrant was executed on the beat throughout April after receiving numerous intel reports of drugs at an address.

### News

#### **Activity throughout April**

On the 24<sup>th</sup> April PC Nik from the beat team went to Orton Place in Earl Shilton. He was joined by staff from Platform Housing, Helen from Earl Shilton Neighbourhood Watch and the Clean Neighbourhoods Team at Hinckley & Bosworth Borough Council. A walk around the location was completed and discussions were had with many residents to help resolve any issues that are occurring in the area through collaborative working with all services. Thank you to all the residents that attended to support this event and made it a success.

PC Nik and PC Tones have been and executed a number of warrants for wanted people across the beat. One of which was arrested and spent the night at Euston Street custody before being returned to prison to complete their sentence. Intel has been generated on the other wanted people.

PC Nik has charged two people to court after they were arrested by response for breaching a Closure Order at an address in Earl Shilton.



#### **Activity throughout April**

On 09/04 PCSO Reed hosted a beat surgery at the Co Op in Earl Shilton where he spoke with a number of local residents. 10/04 the Barwell beat surgery took place at the George Ward Centre. After that a visit to Heath Lane Academy was made with the local youth engagement officer. We spoke and mixed with students during lunch break so they get to familiarise themselves with the local beat team.

11/04 your beat team did a joint patch walk with the council before having to divert to an emergency call of a stolen vehicle in the area. A thorough area search was conducted but there was no trace of the vehicle (investigations are on going). Later on in the shift PC Tones arrested someone for a public order offence after they were causing a few issues in Earl Shilton.

PC Nik assisted response officers from Hinckley, Braunstone and officers from RPU at an RTC in Earl Shilton. Thankfully nobody was injured however the driver spent the night in police custody due to the levels of alcohol in their system. Thank you to all the members of the public that came to assist in the wind and rain until police arrived.
