## What matters to you:

We have listened to you and the concerns you raised and prioritised the following:

#### **Priority 1: Road Safety**

You Said: Speeding and poor driving standards remain a priority for residents of south Wigston.

#### **Priority 2: Anti-Social Behaviour**

You Said: Anti-social behaviour within your area is an ongoing cause for concern. This includes acts of drug taking, excessive noise from vehicles, groups of youths and more.

#### **Priority 3: Vehicle Crime**

You Said: Theft from vehicles, theft of vehicles and vehicles used to commit crime are a growing concern in South Wigston, especially with winter now well and truly upon us.

#### **Road Safety**

Speeding and poor driving standards have again been raised as a priority in South Wigston. Officers continue to carry out frequent high-visibility patrols in vehicles and on foot to provide reassurance to the public and reduce numbers of traffic related offences on the beat. We continue to work with our intelligence teams and neighbouring beats to highlight and catch who pose a risk to other road users.

#### **Antisocial Behaviour**

ASB continues to blight communities across Leicestershire, but in South Wigston we have been working hard to put a stop to the most prolific offenders who continue to cause disruption and upset to residents.

We still have several individuals on Acceptable Behaviour Contracts and which continue to have a significant impact in the reduction of ASB in the area.

We have also been working hard to catch a prolific offender in the area who continues to cause a nuisance to the community and is defying a court ordered inunction to ban them from the area. This individual will find themselves in in prison very soon.

#### **Vehicle Crime**

Reports of vehicle crime remain steady with no notable increase in the area. Residents have voiced their concerns about the potential increase through winter. We continue to patrol hotspot areas and gather intelligence about offences and offenders to ensure we keep disruption and harm to a minimum.

We have also seized numerous vehicles from the streets of Oadby, Wigston and South Wigston for various offences in an effort to keep the roads safe and free from uninsured or dangerous vehicles.



### **Engagements and Events**

Officers attended the Archers Festive Tractor Run this year to support public safety provide assistance with traffic management as the parade passed through South Wigston. This is a fantastic annual event that raises tens of thousands of pounds for LOROS and other local charities.
