What matters to you

Through Neighbourhood Link, social media and local engagement events, we have listened and will be prioritising the following -

Priority - You have reported on-going issues relating to drug use and associated ASB in and around the Trowell street, Pippa Place and Action Man Road areas.

Action Taken - We have engaged with our partners whom you have also shared your concerns with. We are completing a number of high visible patrols in the area.

Priority - You Said - We have received reports from local residents of vehicles travelling at speed in built up residential areas namely Forest Road and the surrounding areas. This causes a road safety issue and is also of concern due to the proximity of the schools in this area.

Action Taken - We Did - Road safety is a continuing priority for all officers within the beat and we will complete speed checks and operations within the area with enforcement where required.

Priority - You Said - You have reported on-going issues with Drugs and ASB in and around the Central Road Hugglescote area which is impacting the local community.

Action Taken - We Did - We are working with partners to address your concerns and bring long term resolutions to the issues reported. We have further measures planned in order to achieve this. We encourage the public to continue to work with us and report issues.
