Local officers from Coleman beat attended a patch walk alongside colleagues from partner agencies including traffic operations, street cleansing, local councillors and local residents. Issues addressed were:

We also visited Gwendolen Gardens on Gwendolen Road to tackle ASB as part of Operation Groove.

#InYourCommunity

PC Barber dealt with a vehicle parked dangerously and blocking a driveway. This vehicle was successfully recovered, ensuring residents are able to exit their driveway. Meanwhile, PCSO Cook has been actively patrolling Sparrow Park and Gwendolen Gardens as part of Operation Groove, a force wide initiative targeting anti-social behaviour in our green spaces. Amongst targeted patrols, a knife sweep was carried out by local officers at Gwendolen Gardens with a positive result of no knives being recovered.

Evington and Coleman beat Sergeant, Chris Hall was live on Kohinoor Radio answering a host of questions:

- Firstly, Sergeant Hall introduced himself as the area Sergeant.

Jailed

This month, James Ward of Avonside Drive pleaded guilty to one count of handling stolen goods at Leicester Crown Court and was sentenced to 27 months' imprisonment.

Ward was found to be in possession of a storage unit key, this was later uncovered by Police to be filled with stolen goods.
