Priority 2: Speeding and Road safety. **What we are going to do:** The beat team will deal with issues of road safety and speeding in Charnwood West villages. If you believe that there is an issue in your area, let the beat team know.

Priority 3: Drugs. **What we are going to do:** The beat team will deal with incidences of drug use and dealing across the beat area. Patrolling identified areas, utilising stop search powers where available and develop intelligence to allow us to target dealing within your area.

The Charnwood West Dedicated Neighbourhood Team have been working throughout September to tackle our chosen priorities of Speeding and Road Traffic Safety, Anti Social Behaviour and Drugs (including use and drug dealing).

All the team featuring Sergeant Adkin, PC Nicholson, PCSO Martin and PCSO Colley have been working both out on the beat engaging with the community, and completing essential behind the scenes administrative work on the below and other aspects of policing:

Speeding and Road Traffic Safety

On 15th October, the NL56 Beat Team conducted a targeted speed enforcement operation with additional support from our response colleagues. The operation focused on Forest Road in Woodhouse and Swithland Lane in Rothley—two areas highlighted by the community for speeding concerns. During the operation, two Traffic Offence Reports (TORs) were issued and two verbal warnings were given. The highest recorded speed was 46mph in a 30mph zone. Alongside enforcement, we've maintained a visible presence in marked police vehicles across other reported hotspots to help deter speeding and reassure residents. We remain committed to keeping our roads safe and welcome continued feedback from the community.

Anti-Social Behaviour

Throughout October, the NL56 Beat Team has carried out numerous visits to victims affected by various forms of anti-social behaviour, offering support and reassurance. We've also engaged directly with perpetrators and taken appropriate action where possible. ASB patrols have been increased in key areas including Ploughlands in Quorn, Castledine Street, and Kinchley Lane, following community reports. Where suitable, officers have applied the Incremental Approach issuing words of advice and warning letters to individuals causing disruption. In Rothley, an ongoing ASB case has resulted in court proceedings, and an eviction process is now underway. We remain committed to tackling ASB and encourage residents to report concerns via 101 or online to help us take timely action.

Drugs and Drug Dealing

The Charnwood West Beat Team has been actively conducting high-visibility patrols in areas linked to drug use and supply, with a particular focus on Quorn, Rothley, Swithland, and Woodhouse Eaves. Officers have been gathering and submitting intelligence on individuals and locations suspected of involvement, which is now being developed to support ongoing investigations. Acting on some of this intelligence, the team executed a Misuse of Drugs Act warrant at an address in Swithland earlier this month. The warrant was successful one male was arrested and illegal substances and equipment were seized. The team continues to work closely with the Neighbourhood Priority Team to address properties and hotspots connected to drug-related activity, reinforcing our commitment to keeping the community safe.
