What matters to you

We have identified the following priorities which are in place as of 1st October 2025:

- **Priority 1: ASB**

You Said: We are aware of issues with youths causing anti-social behaviour in the area of Hillsborough Road and Thurcroft Close. We will be working to tackle this issue moving forward.

We Did: Officers have continued to deter anti-social behaviour in the area. We have noticed a drop in reporting. We believe this is due to a number of young people having been spoken to by Police over the last few months for various issues. We are hopeful that this will deter future issues for a number of repeat victims of ASB. However, we continue to monitor further reports and urge local residents to report any concerns to us via 101 or online so we can continue to tackle this priority effectively.

- **Priority 2: Drug Dealing**

You Said: Drug dealing continues to be a prevalent issue locally.

We Did: We continue to work closely with Leicester City Council where addresses are identified as being involved in drug supply and where Closure Orders may be viable. Due to current ongoing action against various addresses/persons, we are again limited as to the update we can provide this month on this priority—but this priority will continue to be addressed as we enter the new year.

- **Priority 3: Shoplifting**

You Said: There has been an increase in retail theft over the summer months at local stores.

We Did: The beat team have been working with the Co-Op stores on the beat over the last few months who appear to suffer most from repeat shoplifters. We have noted that the number of reports has declined after some positive actions were taken against regular offenders. This work will continue into the new year.
