## What matters to you

From information collated from local surveys, beat knowledge, intelligence and reports to Leicestershire Police, the following areas have been highlighted as priorities within the community:

- **Priority 1: Anti-social use of vehicles and drug use on Aylestone Meadows**

You said: Anti-social behaviour around Dragonfly Walk, particularly during evenings and weekends.

We did: We have only been working on this issue for a couple of weeks. During this time, we have increased our presence in the area and we recently disturbed a group that were suspiciously close to a stolen motorbike, which we subsequently recovered.

- **Priority 2: Develop drug intelligence in this area, which will hopefully allow us to take enforcement**

You said: Offences relating to drugs remain a concern in the area and so we are seeking to develop intelligence in this area, which will hopefully allow us to take enforcement action.

We did: We continue to develop drug intelligence and have carried out enforcement action, for example, we have cleared out multiple addresses where cannabis was being grown. We are particularly interested in anyone that may be dealing, so please continue to pass intelligence to us. - **Priority 3: Anti-social behaviour including drug use in the area of Belvoir Drive**

You said: Anti-Social behaviour in and around Belvoir Drive

We did: We have only been working on this issue for a couple of weeks. During this time, we have increased our presence in the area and have planned some engagement events so that the residents will have the opportunity to speak to us individually. This will enable us to get a better understanding of what is happening and how we can work together to tackle it.
