What matters to you

From information collated from local surveys, beat knowledge, intelligence and reports to Leicestershire Police, the following areas have been highlighted as priorities within the community:

- **Priority 1: Anti-social behaviour and drug activity in the area of Montrose Road.**

You said: Anti Social Behaviour in and around Montrose Road

We did: We have developed intelligence in this area and are looking at what action we can take against specific individuals, though we clearly can't share the details of who or which addresses are involved.

- **Priority 2: Anti-social behaviour, including substance misuse, in the area of Park Hill Drive and Grace Road.**

You said: We responded to an incident that caused a significant amount of concern with residents in the area. A male was arrested and we increased our presence in the area. We have also worked with partner agencies to tackle this issues and attended public meetings to update on our progress, which was well received.

- **Priority 3: Anti-social behaviour in Aylestone Meadows.**

You said: There has been increase reports of anti social behaviour to police in Aylestone meadows

We did: We have increased our presence in Aylestone Meadows and dealt with a number of minor incidents of anti-social behaviour, including the use of motorbikes and drug activity. If you have information that could help us, you can report it anonymously through the Crimestoppers website.

Aylestone Crime and Anti Social Behaviour keeps on falling

The latest available neighbourhood data indicates that overall crime levels in Aylestone have reduced compared with the previous 12-month period, with the annual crime rate showing a 3.3% decrease. Anti-social behaviour remains a key focus for local officers and partners, with ongoing work helping to address concerns raised by local residents.

These positive results are a reflection of the strong relationship between the community, local officers, partner agencies and residents who continue to report concerns and work with us to tackle issues affecting the area. Every piece of information shared by residents helps us identify hotspots, target resources effectively and take action against those responsible for causing harm in our neighbourhoods.
