You Said We Did



This month, PS Brown has been actively engaging with PCSO Sonigra to connect with the Bangladeshi community. Their discussions focused on diverting young people from crime and drug dealing. A key highlight was updating the community on the Dashwood Road Youth Club, which is in the final approval stages and is expected to be operational by the end of the year. We hope by having this facility to close to Evington Road it will help reduce young people being involved in serious & violent crime and ASB. Not only on Evington Road but the wider area.

You Said We Did

As part of our commitment to addressing serious and violent crime on Evington Road, we're focusing on proactive measures rather than just responding to incidents. This month, PS Brown participated in a patch walk with local councillors, the community safety team, and highways representatives. Together, they explored various options to enhance safety on Evington Road. One key proposal discussed was the introduction of a red route to deter dangerous driving and illegal parking, aiming to create a safer environment for all.

We have been actively collaborating with the licensing team regarding businesses on Evington Road seeking to extend their hours into the early morning. Our local police team is concerned that such extensions can attract anti-social behavior and negatively impact the area. We will engage with the council on each application, providing our insights and policing data to oppose those we believe could exacerbate these issues.

With support from our neighborhood proactive team, we successfully arrested an individual and obtained a charge for concerns related to the supply of crack cocaine and heroin. This person has been remanded in custody pending their court hearing. The operation required extensive teamwork to compile the necessary evidence for the criminal prosecution team. We are also pursuing a criminal behavior order to ban this individual from the area. We believe these actions will help deter drug dealing on and around Evington Road, enhancing the safety and well-being of local residents.
