What matters to you

From information collated from local surveys, beat knowledge, intelligence and reports to Leicestershire Police, the following areas have been highlighted as priorities within the community.

Priority 1: Anti-Social Behaviour (ASB) including damage in the area of Disraeli Street.

You said: Anti-social behaviour, including damage and rowdy behaviour in the area of Disraeli Street

We have responded to the reports and have completed Street Consultations and continue to patrol the area to deter and/or identify and deal with those responsible

Priority 2: Drugs

You said: Offences relating to drugs remain a concern in the area and so we are seeking to develop intelligence in this area, which will hopefully allow us to take enforcement action.

Taking Positive Action with our Local Priority's

We have taken positive action and completed Street consultations in our Beat Priority areas. Talking to many new residents in the area and listening to any Policing issues. We have signed some residents to our Neighbourhood Link, which is a free messaging service. Patrols continue in all areas in .

After reports from the public of illegal motorbikes on the field areas on Braunston Lane East. Positive action has been taken and new Section 59 notices have been affixed as well as the area continuing to be patrolled.

After reports of Fly Tipping on the Gilmorton Estate, a Patch Walk with partnership agency was completed. There was evidence of Fly Tipping. This is illegal, so please dispose of all rubbish and large items correctly.
