

## You said - We did

- Speeding (34 votes on Neighbourhood Link (NHL)). Between 01/05/2025 and 31/05/2025 the mobile speed camera visited the A47 four times, the B6047 seven times, the A6 twice, the A6003 once and Glen Road in Newton Harcourt twice. In total thirteen offences were detected.
- Anti social behaviour (21 votes on NHL) identifying individuals causing the anti social behaviour. Passing their names to the council to start the incremental approach. Targeting areas of known ASB activity.
- Nuisance motorbikes (19 votes on NHL) We have been conducting uniformed and marked vehicle patrols in the areas you have told us this is a problem. We have directed officers to these areas in any down time they have to deter these offenders from causing problems in these areas.

This month saw the Rural Crime Team deploy to Tilton on the Hill. A number of vehicles were stopped, usual police checks completed and the drivers then educated by the team from Leicestershire Fire and Rescue Service Road Safety.

Of note it was great to be approached by members of the community interested in the operation and also taking the opportunity to get into the Fire Services specialised vehicle "Hazard Express" and watch both the equestrian and fatal four videos. If you see this van out and about, take the opportunity to have a go inside.

It has been refreshing to see a decline in drivers requiring the teams education and warnings. The feedback has been positive both for horse riders and residents, telling us the speed of vehicles in the rural villages having reduced.

Advice for drivers:

- 🚗 slow down to 10mph
- be patient (do not sound horn or rev your engine)
- pass wide when safe to do so (2 metres distance)
- 🚗 drive away slowly

Advice for riders:

- A be alert to your surroundings at all times
- use hand signals to communicate
- wear hi-vis and reflective equipment
- A be courteous (allow traffic to pass)
- be polite (make eye contact and thank drivers)
