What matters to you

We have listened to you and the concerns you raised and will Prioritize the following from March 2025.

Priority 1: ASB. You said: You have concerns around anti- social behavior across the village. We will continue to try and disrupt this type of behavior and use the ASB incremental approach to deter offenders.

Priority 2: Speeding. You said: You are concerned about vehicles speeding in the villages. We will continue to monitor and enforce speed across several sites in the village.

Priority 3: Burglaries. We aim to work with the relevant authorities to reduce the burglaries across the village and to try and reduce the number of reported thefts from the recycling Centre. Visiting victims and prevention advice.

April

Priority 1: The beat team aim to tackle different elements of ASB in Mountsorrel

Following on from last month, I advised that there had been a report of antisocial behavior (ASB) and criminal damage at Mountsorrel Memorial Park. Enquiries into this incident remain ongoing, and any updates will be published as soon as they become available.

We continue to patrol local hotspots, providing a high-visibility presence within the community.

I am pleased to report that there have been no significant reports of antisocial behavior during the past month.

Priority 2: The beat team aim to target reports of speeding in Mountsorrel.

Speed Ops

We have carried out speed checks on Walton Way, Mountsorrel as part of ongoing efforts to improve road safety in the area.

Speed checks are conducted at various times of the day and throughout the week. The previous speed check at this location took place during the evening, and this month's check was completed during the morning. This now completes monitoring at both times of the day.

Across both enforcement periods, approximately 200 vehicles were monitored, and all drivers were found to be travelling within the speed limit.

Priority 3: Burglaries

I am pleased to report that there have been no reported burglaries during this month. This is a positive reflection of the continued efforts being made to deter crime and keep our community safe.

High-visibility patrols remain in place throughout both daytime and night-time hours. These patrols aim to provide reassurance to residents while also acting as a proactive deterrent to offending.

The Neighbourhood Team is further supported by our response colleagues, who continue to work closely with us to ensure a swift and effective response to any incidents or concerns raised by members of the public.
