Leicestershire Police will always continue to support our retailers in crime prevention.


#### What We Will Do

- At the time of your report, you will be given an incident number.
- If lines of enquiry are identified from your initial report, the report will be allocated to a Police Officer and they will be in contact to discuss the incident with you.
- We will retrieve a copy of the CCTV footage that you saved and stored showing the incident.
- You will be informed if a suspect has been identified and how your report will be progressed.
- You will be informed if a suspect is interviewed and charged with an offence or if they have been dealt with in another way.
- You will be informed if your case is closed because a suspect has not been identified or there is not enough evidence to pursue a prosecution.

#### What You Need to Do

- Collate information noted in this pack about the incident.
- Tell us if you know who is responsible, even if you do not support further action.
- Ensure staff are available to assist us.
- If a shop worker has been assaulted or abused tell us. This is important and we will respond in the most appropriate way.







#### **CCTV**

The CCTV footage should show the time, date and all of the suspect(s) movements. This includes entry to the store, the taking of goods, moving past the point of payment and exiting the store. All activity when in the premises should be captured on CCTV.

If the clock on the CCTV system is incorrect, please indicate by how much in the MG11 witness statement. All CCTV times should be in hours, minutes and seconds.

#### **MG11 Witness Statement**

On the following page is an example of an MG11 Witness Statement which would be required to pursue a prosecution.

The police officer conducting the investigation will take a statement from a staff member in person or on the phone. Please ensure staff are available to assist police with this.

The statement should include the points to prove of the offence:

"On (date and location), dishonestly appropriated property belonging to another from a shop with the intention to permanently deprive another of it"

In simple terms, it should include:

- The suspect entering the store
- The suspect taking the goods
- The type, number and value of goods taken
- The suspect leaving the store without making any offer of payment
- The suspect not having permission to leave the store without making payment
- The suspect's details if known
- The CCTV footage exhibited
