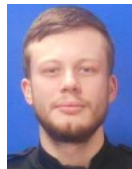
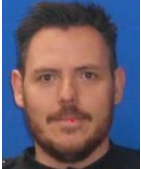

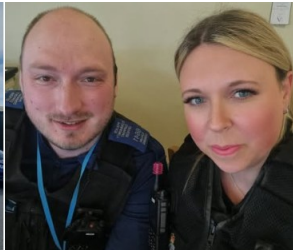
Your priorities are chosen quarterly and are based upon information gathered through NHL (Neighbourhood Link), social media, local engagement, and emerging crime trends. You have stated that the following key themes are important to you. #YouSaidWeDid

You Said	We did
Burglaries both residential and commercial.	We've had 2 reported burglaries within Blaby and a commercial break at Hayes travel. CCTV, house to house and forensics have all been considered and the investigation continues.
General ASB, congregating youths e-scooters and bikes.	Holmes Park, Whetstone – 30 youths climbing onto the private site – Group of youths climb onto locked football pitches – Officers attended and dispersed the group from the site. No damage was caused.
Road Safety including car cruising, anti-social driving and vehicle safety has been highlighted by the public as an issue.	We have received reports of a nuisance driver in a vehicle, driving up and down at speed and driving without tax. The Beat team are aware and are actively looking to seize the vehicle.

PCSO Loades assisted in the capture of a shoplifter in Blaby. He was flagged down by an off duty Police Officer who had seen the suspect run out of the Savers store followed by staff. Although initially losing sight they caught up with the male on Lutterworth Road who was promptly arrested. All the goods totalling nearly £170 were returned to the store. The 44 year old male was charged with theft, which he admitted and will be attending Court soon.

After receiving intelligence in relation to this Audi TT after it had been seen driving with no tax and no insurance, a short game of hide and seek, we managed to locate it on Main Street, Cosby (possibly not the best hiding place).

The Blaby Beat Team is aware of ongoing concerns from local residents regarding the increased use of illegal e-bikes on our roads and in community spaces. Where possible, we are taking positive action to address this issue. Officers stopped and seized this e-bike in Whetstone after it was seen travelling at speed on roads and footpaths. The e-bike will be destroyed, and the rider has been reported for the relevant traffic offences.



We received a report of a suspected rogue trader incident involving roofing repairs in the Hill View Drive area of Cosby. The individuals were believed to be cold calling at addresses, offering roof repairs and other related work. Rogue traders may claim urgent issues with roofing, point out "damage" from ground level, or pressure residents into agreeing to work immediately. Stay Alert.
