You said - We did

- Speeding (10 votes on Neighbourhood Link (NHL)). Between 01/05/2025 and 31/05/2025 the mobile speed camera visited the A4303 Lubenham Hill for a total of 81 minutes. Eight offences were detected.
- Anti social behaviour (10 votes on NHL) - identifying individuals causing the anti social behaviour. Passing their names to the council to start the incremental approach. Targeting areas of known ASB activity.
- Drug dealing (11 votes on NHL) - We have been conducting plain clothes patrols in areas we are told drug dealing is an issue. We collect intelligence from residents and CrimeStoppers and apply for magistrates warrants and conduct drugs raids on those we suspect of dealing in drugs. We encourage anyone to report drug dealing to us anonymously through CrimeStoppers.

This month, one of our local officers was accompanied by Councillor David Page for a few hours of his shift, patrolling through Market Harborough and onto Gartree and Wellington place. This was to carry out some patrols and visits to local residents and shop owners. It was good to hear their thoughts on matters current to the area. Residents voicing their concerns but also praising the visibility of officers in and around the town.

It was also good to speak with the Councillor Page about various matters that are currently affecting the local area, showing how important it is that we work closely with our partners in the community.

On a late shift recently, the local Neighbourhood Priority Team were extremely busy with a number of different tasks around the priorities you told us were important to you.

They completed arrest attempts this for outstanding suspects for on-going investigations & assisted response colleagues with incidents.

Whilst completing patrols in Market Harborough they spotted a vehicle on Kings Road where after conducting a stop search on the driver, he was found to be in possession of cannabis. He was also drug wiped and failed this test, he has subsequently been arrested. Further enquires into the driver have established he also had a provisional licence and no insurance for the vehicle.
