What matters to you

We have listened to you and the concerns that you raised to us in July 2023. We identified the following priorities:

Priority 1: ASB

You Said: Anti-Social Behaviour in the area was of concern to you.

We did: We identified that a number of abandoned and derelict buildings in the area have been targeted for crime and ASB. We have worked with the owners of these properties to enhance their security which should reduce the likelihood of similar incidents taking place.

Priority 2: Burglary and vehicle crime

You said: That burglary and vehicle crimes were of concern to you.

We did: We have dedicated officers proactively patrolling the area. Only this week officers caught two persons pushing a stolen motor bike in the area. Despite their best efforts to make off, we arrested and charged both males and returned the bike to its owner who had not even realised it had been taken.

Priority 3: Road Safety

You said: That road safety was a concern to you

We did: We listened to local resident's concerns about speeding and vehicles failing to give way in and around the Queens Road/Northcote Road junction. Unfortunately we recently attended a collision at this location and reported the person at fault. PCSO HAND completed a speeding operation to deter drivers and to raise awareness of our continued presence in that area as we know the road can get very busy, particularly in the early evening.

What are we doing moving forwards?

Moving forwards you can expect to receive more frequent communications from our Neighbourhood Team, particularly on the police website and on social media. We believe it is important for you to understand the work we are completing and we can only do so by making this visible and easily accessible to the public.

As we are now in the middle of the summer, we know that certain types of crimes do rise. Please be vigilant regarding the security of your properties, particularly in warm weather when windows and doors are often left open.

We will continue to develop and react to intelligence, utilising our police powers to disrupt criminality and proactively target those that cause harm in your area.
