#YouSaid - What matters to you

Below are our beat priorities with updates as to what the team have done throughout April 2025.

Priority:

Addressing issues with anti-social behaviour across the beat, particularly in the open spaces, such as street drinking, fly tipping and parking issues.

Action taken:

We have taken part in joint agency work with Leicester City Council partners to target those parking dangerously in the vicinity of schools in the area. We have a patch walk in planning to address fly tipping, particularly in the Kate Street/Tudor Road areas.

Priority:

Dealing with the production of class B drugs on the area, in addition to tackling the use and supply of both class A and B drugs in areas where this affects the local community.

Action taken:

In April we have conducted numerous stop checks, with at least 4 leading to positive results where controlled drugs have been recovered. We have arrested and charged a male suspected of dealing drugs in the Dannett Walk, Rally park areas. This work has resulted in this male serving the remainder of an existing sentence meaning he will be in HMP until 2029.

Priority:

Improving road safety on the ward around speeding on the arterial routes, in addition to the illegal/unsafe use of e-scooters and electric bikes on roads and footpaths.

Action taken:

We continue to take a phased approach to the use of e-scooters on roads and footpaths. Enforcement is planned for those who fail to heed warnings.

Firstly, we'd like to welcome PC Abbie Ward to the Fosse beat. Abbie has come over from the West Leicester response team and is so far enjoying being on the beat. I'm sure in time you will see her out and about and you can say hello :)

This month has been a busy one with various arrests on the beat, as well as helping other neighbouring beats with prolific offenders.

The Fosse Neighbourhood Team apprehended and arrested a male for x2 PWITS, and helped put together a case for our NPO colleagues to secure a charge for him. This male will now be moving into his new home at HMP until 2029.

There have been four positive stop checks which has resulted in arrests due to these person's being in possession of drugs, and a male was caught drug dealing on Rally park so needless to say he was arrested too. A positive outcome for the month due to drugs being one of our beat priorities to help tackle!

We have supported agencies with two evictions on the beat this month, also. These persons were causing issues where they lived, committing crime, so hopefully the neighbouring properties are living more of a peaceful life now!

There is a running Anti Social Behaviour contract being ran by PCSO Clarke due to a local youth who can't seem to keep himself out of trouble. The team are supporting this contract as well as the council.

As always, patrols have been carried out extensively over the ward, gathering intelligence and speaking to members of the public. Beat surgeries have also taken place whereby those who have attended have raised there concerns.
